Commit Participants

Found people who are willing to attend

- Obtain consent
- Give information about management of sensitive results, If any
- Inducement: Let them be as little as possible
- Deception, betray: they are not to prefer, and should be possibly to exclude. If deception is applied it should be explained and revealed to the participants as early as possible.

Instrumentation Concerns

- Implementation of forms, guidelines, materials
- Registration of information concerning the expected participating subjects
- Training

Execution

- Real-time tailoring of the design at execution time
 - Is there impact on data collection forms?
 - Is there impact on the experimental environment?
