

How many countries are members of the United Nations?



What was the last country to become a member of the United Nations?



Which of the following UN organs has the authority to issue binding resolutions on all member states?






Correct answer:

Boutros Boutros-Ghali: sixth Secretary-General from January 1992 to December 1996... he died on 16 February 2016.


Kofi Annan: seventh Secretary-General from January 1997 to December 2006... he died on 18 August 2018.




Correct answer:






