<b>Over 30 % (over 10% for each resource)</b>	<b>Inform the Supervisor and the Coordinator.</b>	<b>Meet the student to discuss about the high similarity index and suggest how to reduce the percentage.</b>	<b>If the similarity index is not reduced, the thesis will be rejected.</b>
